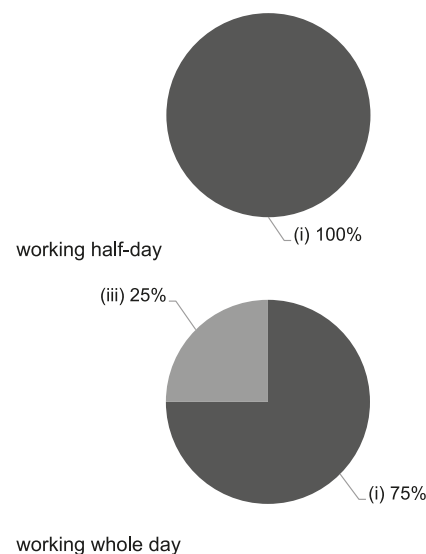

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

<p>Thematic teaching activities are carried out in small groups to cultivate students self-learning and active spirit of exploration through games, outdoor visits and competitions. Besides this, teaching of English by native English teachers enhances the children's self-confidence in expression and communication.</p>

<p>Our school keeps records of children's learning achievements and behavior by continuous observation. At the end of each semester, we hold consultations with students' parents to discuss their children's learning experiences.</p>

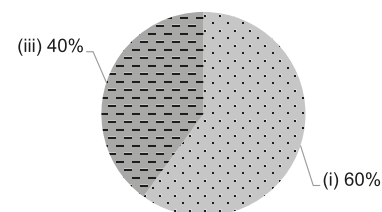
