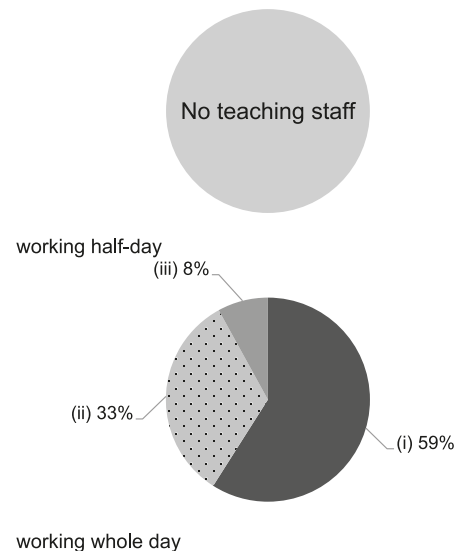

The effective integration of both the explicit and the implicit courses lays a good foundation for children's whole person development.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

We expect children to raise their standards in different learning areas and to carry along with them early on abilities that serve them for the long-term.</p>

Through quantitative and qualitative continuous observation, we collect performance evidences and carry out objective analysis to evaluate children's development level and ability. 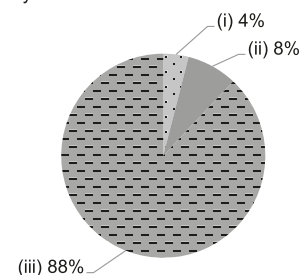
