Curriculum Details

Curriculum type : Local

Curriculum planning

Closely in line with the pace of education reform, we follow Education Bureau's latest guidelines to design curriculum suitable to children's interests, abilities and experience, which enable them to learn and communicate with peers in the drama lesson that can provide pleasant and relaxing games-filled environment.

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

Our child-centred approach promotes diversified forms of learning, that often involves bringing children out of the classroom to visit various places for outdoor personal experiences and learning, complemented by flexible use of IT in helping our students well prepared to keep up with the times. Native English and Mandarin teachers are recruited to enhance children's language skills. Grasshopper Scout Ring and Flag-guard have been established to boost teamwork and social communication skills. In recent years, we have been actively implementing drama education for children to acquire knowledge and self-confidence through performances and reinforce friendships during review and sharing sessions.

Assessment of children's learning experiences

We carry out continuous and summative assessment through observation, recording and analysis, and establish a three-year individual learning portfolio to enable parents in achieving a more holistic understanding of their children's learning, physical and mental development.

School Characteristics

School vision and mission

We provide a quality and comprehensive early childhood education to promote all-round development through a stimulating and diversified curriculum and activities to spark children's thinking, creativity and potential, and to cultivate correct values and sound moral character.

New entrants orientation week, class promotion adaptation week, Primary One classes simulation week, visits to primary schools and community facilities, topical talks for children, diversified interest activities, full-times classes are available .

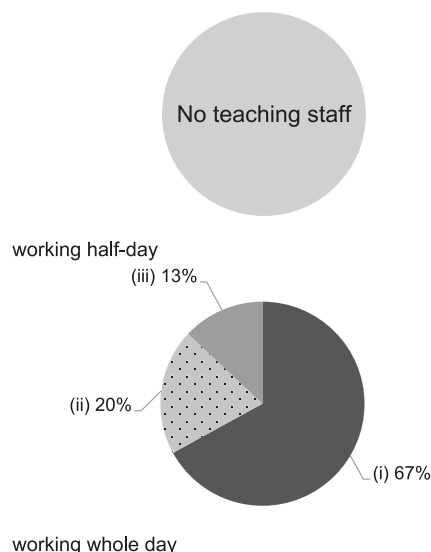

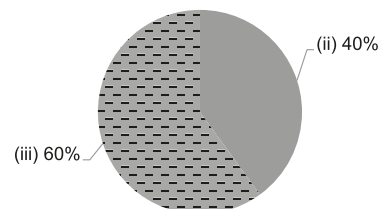
Monthly salary range of principal & teaching staff
