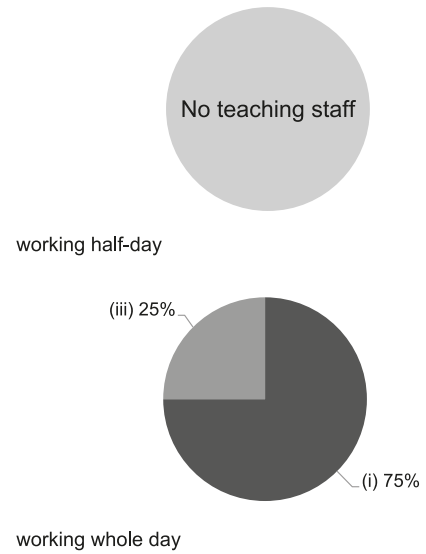

Curriculum planning	
<p>Our curriculum uses "stories" to integrate various development areas. Children attempt to learn through discussions. During the learning process, we encourage children to express their personal views and we induce them to think from multiple perspectives and to apply what they have learnt on their daily lives, so as to enhance their ability to solve problems. Apart from trilingual learning, we actively implement the parent-child reading program to cultivate children's interest in reading early on.</p> <p>We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>	
Learning / Teaching approach & activities	
<p>We believe that children are active learners. They are curious and like to explore new things. That's why we provide an enriched environment and suitable guidance for children to explore and acquire knowledge actively. We cultivate their positive attitude and initiative for learning. We encourage children to interact and learn from each other, learn to appreciate others and help each other, to develop good interpersonal relationships and improve social skills.</p>	
Assessment of children's learning experiences	
<p>We record children's development through continuous observation; games are also used for assessing children's learning progress while children's works are used to show children's learning results. Teachers create for each child a growth portfolio, which records every stage of a child's growth.</p>

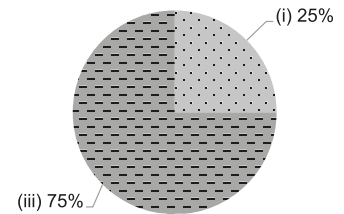

<p>Adopting the child-oriented approach, we develop children's potential through teachers' devoted guidance for children's learning. We put an emphasis on cultivating children's good character and interest in reading.</p>

<p>Learning contents are adjusted properly according to children's individual abilities, so that they could learn at their own pace. Through on-going observatory assessment, we get to know children's strengths and abilities that should be further developed. We give appropriate encouragement and support and foster children's motivation for self-directed learning, so that they get to know their own abilities and build up confidence from the learning process.</p>
