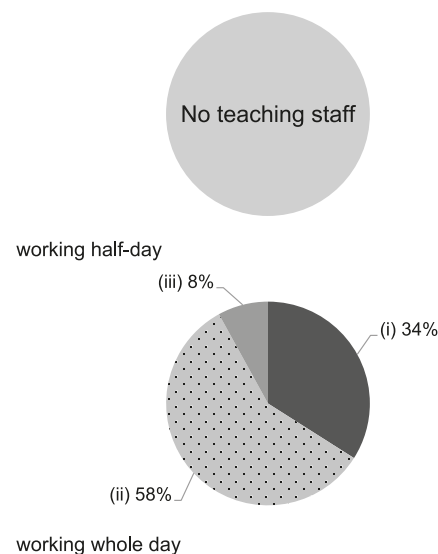

Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.</p>

Diversified, systematic and inspiring classroom environment is provided and teaching is conducted in the forms of games and activities. 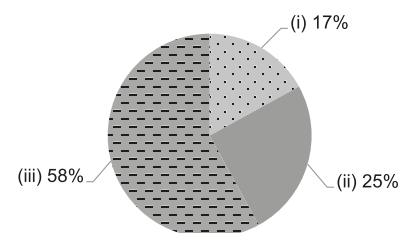
