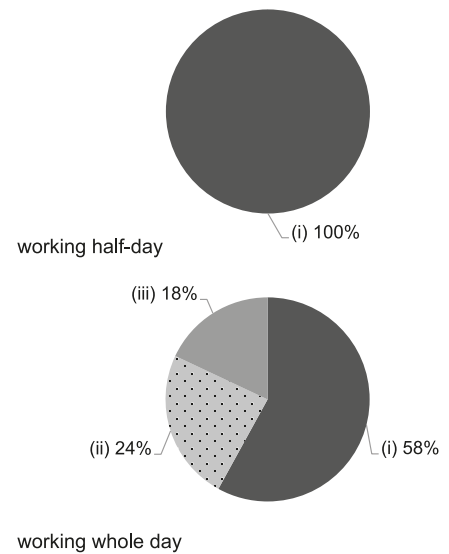

<p>Integrated curriculum adopted by us: We adopt the teaching modes of "Project Approach", "theme-based learning" and "picture-book instruction" and design the curriculum contents according to children's interests, help children learn to explore and observe via life experience, develop different areas of learning, adopt flexible and interesting methods, leverage authentic teaching materials and arrange visiting activities to stimulate children's learning motivation, creative thinking and ability to solve problems and cooperate with others. Language: Based on children's learning interests, we adopt "story approach", leverage the real situation and provide diversified activities and games to improve children's ability to listen, read, express and understand words. We offer The Language Learning Package for Pre-primary Children (school-based language curriculum) and set clear learning objectives and systematic teaching procedures to help general children systematically master language learning skills.</p>

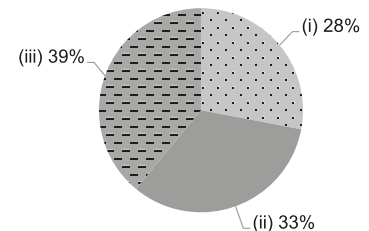
